The goal in this puzzle is to put the pieces of the story back in “chronological” order, from the point of view of the time traveller. This can be done by looking for clues in the text about what the traveller does and doesn’t know at the time he wrote each entry. Also, some entries reference earlier ones in the timeline (for example, “I ate fish the last time I was here”).

After you put the entries in order, connect the dots on the large circular diagram in chronological order. Each line you draw intersects with only one floating letter. Reading the letters in order gives the answer, PETRICHOR.
